PREMIERE SEASON OF BOY SWALLOWS UNIVERSE EXTENDED AGAIN TO MEET OVERWHELMING DEMAND FOR TICKETS

The season in QPAC's Playhouse, which begins on **Monday 30 August** and runs throughout Brisbane Festival, has been extended for a fifth week with its final curtain call on **Sunday 3 October**.

Brisbane Festival Artistic Director **Louise Bezzina** said she was delighted – but not surprised – at how enthusiastically audiences from Brisbane, and beyond, had embraced the brand-new production from the moment it went on sale.
