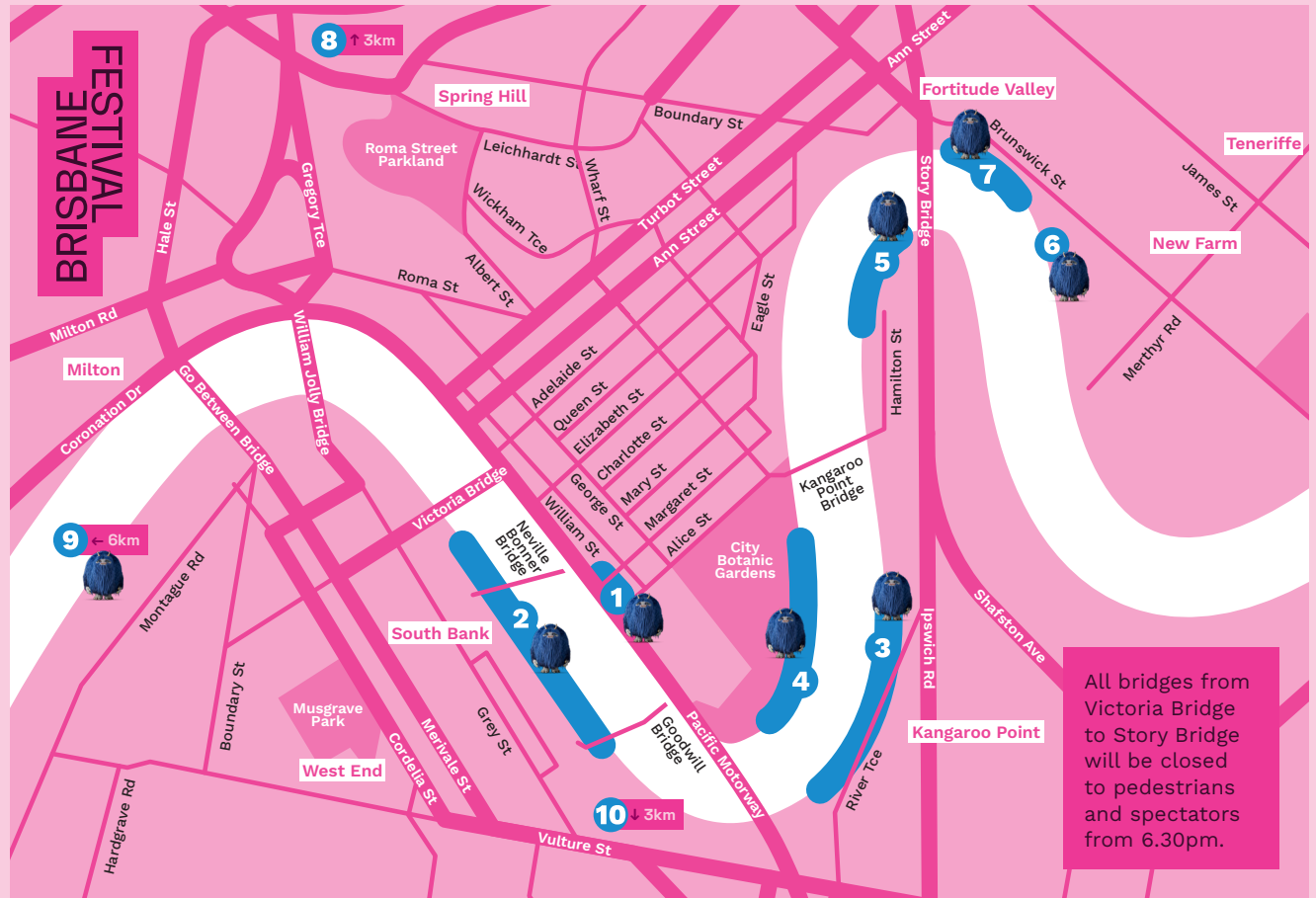

1 The Star Precinct

Across the Neville Bonner Bridge, The Star precinct has a variety of great spots to view the colourful spectacle. From The Star itself to the nearby parks, this is a great place to see everything.

2 South Bank

The heart of the action, South Bank, will come alive as the place to be for those who want to get close to the action and get in on the celebration.

3 Kangaroo Point Cliffs

The cliffs offer breathtaking, elevated views of the fireworks, making it one of the most popular spots for a panoramic experience over the Brisbane River

4 City Botanic Gardens

A classic spot with a beautiful riverside setting. The gardens will also be home to the magnificent *Afterglow* experience.

5 Captain Burke Park

Located beneath the Story Bridge, this park offers a cosy and intimate setting for enjoying the fireworks close to the river.

6 Wilson Outlook Reserve

A smaller but elevated vantage point with stunning views of the Story Bridge and the city skyline, perfect for capturing the fireworks.

7 Howard Smith Wharves

A riverside location with multiple excellent dining options, with spectacular views of the fireworks over the river.

8 Victoria Park/Barrambin

A great location for a relaxed viewing experience, perfect for picnicking with friends and family while you watch the show.

9 Mt Coot-tha Lookout

For one of the highest vantage points in Brisbane, Mt Coot-tha Lookout offers panoramic views of the fireworks display. Before the fireworks, take some time to explore the nearby Botanic Gardens.

10 Highgate Hill Park

Enjoy the fireworks from this heritage-listed site that offers a fantastic vantage point over the city.
